### **Signature Employment Grants**

National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation (Washington, DC) - To advance individuals with disabilities along a hospitality career pathway by delivering sequenced training, employment, and advancement opportunities through community collaboratives, which include community-based organizations and industry. \$250,000.

University of Massachusetts Boston, Institute for Community Inclusion (Boston, MA) - To enable teams of employment consultants and their managers to visualize their employment supports, reflect, set goals, and take action to improve the implementation of research-based employment supports and thus improve job seekers' employment outcomes. \$250,000.

### **Foundation Directed Grants**

Association of University Centers on Disabilities (Silver Springs, MD) - To participate in monthly nTide Lunch and Learn webcast providing "News from the Field" in the first webcast of the month and participating in midmonth webcasts to brief news from Washington and answer questions. \$25,000.

University of New Hampshire (Durham, NH) - To build upon past KFNEDES surveys, the 2024 KFNEDES: Hospitality Industry seeks to delve deeper into the practices used to recruit people with disabilities and provide workplace accommodation. \$250,000.
